Thank you for your interest in applying to participate in the Wadsworth Scholars program.

This program is intended to encourage exploration of golf course architecture as a career path, for both students and those already involved in the golf industry, by attending an ASGCA Annual Meeting. It is funded by the Wadsworth Golf Charities, Wadsworth Golf Course Construction, and the American Society of Golf Course Architects Foundation (ASGCAF). This program will select two college students of junior rank or higher, as well as two non-students showing an interest and aptitude for golf course development.

The ASGCAF is looking for candidates who would benefit from understanding more about the profession by spending time with golf course architects at the ASGCA Annual Meeting: attending professional development seminars and social functions, and playing golf. The ASGCAF hopes to support those who would like to enter the profession with scholarship funding and access to golf course architects/professional development, and to help its members get to know people who could one day be colleagues or employees.

Scholarship Award: Those selected will be invited to attend the 2023 ASGCA Annual Meeting in Milwaukee, for one or two days of professional development seminars, social functions, the Donald Ross Award Banquet, and a round of golf with ASGCA members. In addition, each recipient will receive \$2,500 and travel expenses to the meeting, lodging, and some meals paid for. The meeting is scheduled for Oct. 2 – 5, with exact dates for award recipients to attend to be determined.

How to apply: To be selected requires submitting the attached form, answering the short questions, and composing the essay question. Attach your answers to the form and send it to the review committee at the address listed on the form. Application deadline is June 2, 2023, and selected individuals will be notified in mid-summer.

If you are seriously considering a career in golf course design, this is your opportunity to meet active practitioners, learn about ASGCA and network with golf industry leaders.
